

Best Bulls in the Industry



Selection strategy:

1. Birth Weight: Our Sires are chosen by having a birth weight as low as possible. In most cases under 100 lbs.
2. Calving ease: Any animal with birthing problems is removed from the herd
3. Milk Production: One of the main criteria for our cows is the weaning weight. Our animals live on only grass with an average weaning weight of 600 lbs.
4. ADG: WE test the top 10% of our animals and retain only the best. In 2014 the best our animals could do was 6.69 lbs per day.
5. RFI: We like feed efficient animals and use RFI as one of the tests to help select our best sires
