## **FUTURITY RULES AND INFORMATION FOR CONGRESS 2020**

- Futurity classes are open to all Fullblood, Purebred, and Percentage heifer and bull calves registered with the CMAA.
- Qualifying shows for 2018 will be held at
  - Lindsay Exhibition Sept. 19-23 Lindsay ON.
  - Farmfair International Nov. 7-11 Edmonton, AB
  - Canadian Western Agribition Nov. 19-24 Regina, SK.
- 2018 fall shows entry deadlines are fast approaching so make sure to get entries in on time.
- Animals must be **entered and shown** each year in the open show at a qualifying show, once show entries are made, please contact a congress committee member to get your calves entered in the futurity.
- The entry fee is \$20/animal/year starting this fall, with the finale in 2020 at Congress at Agribition.
- Heifers and bulls must be shown each year to be eligible for the futurity.
- There are not separate classes for futurity entries, until Congress. By entering and showing in the open show at the qualifier you make your heifer and/or bull eligible for the futurity as long as the congress committee has been contacted and has them registered minimum one week prior to the show, there will not be a points system.
- The cow-calf pairs and mature bulls in the finale of the futurity will be judged at the 2020 congress and futurity champion prizes will be awarded.
